3. Steps to Prepare for Academic Advisement

- Schedule an appointment with the advisor (preferably via email)
- Review the suggested course sequence for Music majors (based on track selection)
 - [Vocal Track](#)
 - [Instrumental Track](#)
 - [Piano or Organ Track \(Keyboard Track\)](#)
- Review Degree Works audit *ahead of time* and know the classes you would like to take
- Know current academic standing
- Have familiarity with necessary advisement tools.
- Bring questions and required forms (e.g., *Departmental Checklist*, *Override Request*, *Excess Credits*, *Track Selection*, and *Credit Audit Evaluation*).
- If meeting in person, bring a mobile device and/or laptop, tablet, and/or writing utensil. Be prepared to take notes.
- Prepare to store the alternative pin in a safe location (that can be accessed during and after advisement)
- If meeting in person, plan to arrive a bit earlier than scheduled. Have all necessary documents (e.g., Curriculum checklist). Meetings may also take place over email or virtually.
